STUDENT ART ENTRY AND INFORMATION

Students of Springwood High School are invited to enter their artworks into the 2019 Springwood Art Show. A wide range of mediums can be exhibited, including painting, photography, mixed media, sculpture and sketching. Springwood Art Show is organised by the P&C of our school as a fundraiser for resources for our students.

WHY ENTER ARTWORKS?

- It is FREE for Springwood High School students to enter your artworks.
- There are specific prizes for SHS student entries:

Viewers' Choice (SHS Students) donated by Ashton Aviation Services are voted by visitors to the show

First prize \$150
 Second Prize \$75
 Third Prize \$50
 Fourth Prize \$25

Year Prizes of \$100 for the artwork judged as best in each year, donated by Dr. Eva Jackson

- Students are also eligible to win the main art show prizes, including the \$1500 overall winner prize, photography, portrait prizes and the \$250 Youth Art Prize for under 21 year olds. Good luck!
- Students can also choose to sell their artworks if they would like but selling your work is not compulsory.

HOW DO I ENTER?

- Artworks for the show need to be delivered to the CAPA department by Friday, July 26th, 2019.
- Complete the application form (below) and bring it along when you submit your artwork to.
- All artworks need to be framed (stretched canvas is considered framed) and must include wire or cord ready for hanging. Your CAPA teacher can help with getting works ready to be hung, or they may coordinate the artworks from the class. Your teacher will let you know if this is the case.

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- The SHS artwork prizes are chosen by viewers' choice (everyone seeing the show gets to vote). All student awards are announced at 3pm on Sunday, August 4.
- Put your name, address, title of the artwork, medium (and price if relevant) on the back or base of your artwork.
- Please limit the size of your work to 90cm x 120cm as space will be limited.
- The Art Show organisers will take all reasonable care with your work but we are not responsible if there is any damage done.
